Secretary's Report

Life can deal some cruel blows, the loss of our dear friend Shirley Carr has been hard to bear for many of us.

She will be completely irreplaceable, that goes without saying really. Tributes to her will be found in the pages of Affi and we intend to honour her incredible contribution to afghan rescue by having a Shirley Carr Memorial Stakes Class each year at the Championship Show. The proceeds from the entries will go directly to rescue and there will be a perpetual memorial trophy plus cash prizes. The Committee felt this was a lasting acknowledgement to the commitment and work she has given to all of those rescued afghan hounds over so many years.

Our year has been profitable and the shows successful. Once again we were able to hold two well supported Open Shows: early January was a welcome event for our members and here our judge was Pat Kirwan (Padaki). He chose for BIS/BD Harrison's **Sarakhan Sultan al Kabira JW ShCM**, RBIS/BB Hitch's **Zendushkas Sparkling Rosé**, BPIS went to Busby's **Syrdarya Malted Milk at Wilbus JW**.

Our second Club Open show was held in March, and our judge was Richard Thompson (Gothika) whose choices were: BIS/BD, **Sarakhan Sultan al Kabira JW ShCM**, RBIS/RBD Buttle's **Sarakhan Shamir JW ShCM**. BB Coombes' **Gilari Devil Woman**. BPIS Lancashire's **Drishaun It Ain't Over**.

Our AGM followed, and we welcomed Paul Smart and Neil Straw to our Committee whose enthusiasm will surely benefit the Club for the future. Those present at the meeting agreed for the Club to rejoin the Breed Council to ensure our continued involvement and participation with ongoing discussion in these precarious times of CC allocation.

Our Championship Show judges were both awarding CCs for the first time, having been supported by the Club. Julie Noble (Dogs) and our own Treasurer, Bronwyn Lawson-Ball (Bitches); a double whammy for litter brother and sister, BIS/DCC went to Young and West's **Ch Andizhan Baal at Shirobana JW ShCM** and RBIS/BCC to Scott's **Andizhan Bakhtuu Arushkhan**. BPIS went to Thompson's **Gezancol Smoke and Mirrors at Gothika**. BVIS was Andrew's **Ch Andizhan Arateekah**, dam of Dog and Bitch CC winners. Our thanks to the many friends and supporters, who also helped out at the show to make things run smoothly.

Trophies for the points winners were given out during the lunch break: the John Conibear Memorial Trophy was won by Scott's **Andizhan Bakhtuu Arushkhan**; the Jill and Ernie Dyson Trophy was won by Buttle's **Sarakhan Shamir JW ShCM**, Best Veteran (Shah Walden Trophy) was awarded to Fielder's **Ch Miamarna True to Garamond**, and finally the Best Puppy Award, The Severndene Trophy, was won by Lancashire's **Sumahari Carolina Cherry for Drishaun**. This year's points winners presentations will be made at the Championship Show. Please see the relevant notifications and photos in Affi, and on the Club website.

Dates for next year are 5th January and 5th October for the Open Shows, please note because of the rotational system for Breed Clubs there are no CCs in 2014 and we will need your full support please for our Back-to-Back Open Shows in October. The AGM is scheduled for 30th March and during the morning we have planned a Breed Specific Seminar. Mark Cocozza (Freecloud) will be our guest Speaker for the talk and presentation. We hope that numbers will be high for what should prove to be a very interesting and informative day and that you take the opportunity to have lunch with us and stay for the AGM which will follow in the early afternoon.

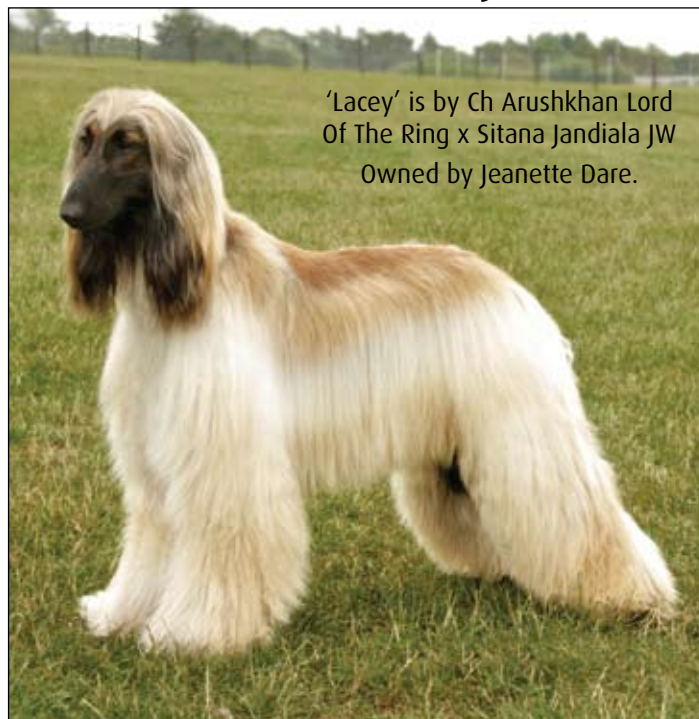

Treasurer's Report

Our accounts show that the past year has been financially successful so we are on the right track. Members at the AGM agreed that the committee would pick our Judges for the Shows and it has proven to be the right thing for the club as all of our three shows again showed a healthy profit with an overall show income increase by 43.4% which is amazing in these current times.

Sales have been strong and purchases were kept to a minimum but throughout this year we have been looking for new and interesting things to tempt you, so don't forget to visit the stall. At Crufts 2013 there were only two Breed Club Stands present, it has become so expensive, not good for the Breed but excellent for the Western in terms of sales!

During 2012 we have made some much needed purchases to enhance the profile of the club these being Gazebos, customised ringtape and new tablecloths; costs for these items will be spread over and written off during the next 4 years.

Affi magazine also made a profit, mainly due to the hard work of our Secretary Jill Cross canvassing for adverts and finding a very cost effective printer, Affi is one of the best magazines produced for the Breed and I am sure you would agree it would be a shame to lose it, this is down to you. This year we have a special edition to celebrate our Ruby Show; due to the Kennel Club rotation we lose our allocation of CCs in 2014 so your support for the Club and its Magazine would be greatly appreciated.

The rescue fund, due to the short term high interest rate account raised, has proven a sound investment over the past two years. We carried it forward again for this year and will continue to do so until ordinary interest rates become more lucrative. As there was a minimum threshold for this type of account our ordinary account could not benefit for the same rates, but due to the increase of the club's assets we have managed this year to do a similar savings account. I will continue to assess the situation and with the member's authority, place our savings to gain the best interest possible.

In closing I would like to thank the Members and Committee for their support, and our Accountant, Ellen Hopper, who has not only given her time freely, but is always on hand for sound advice.

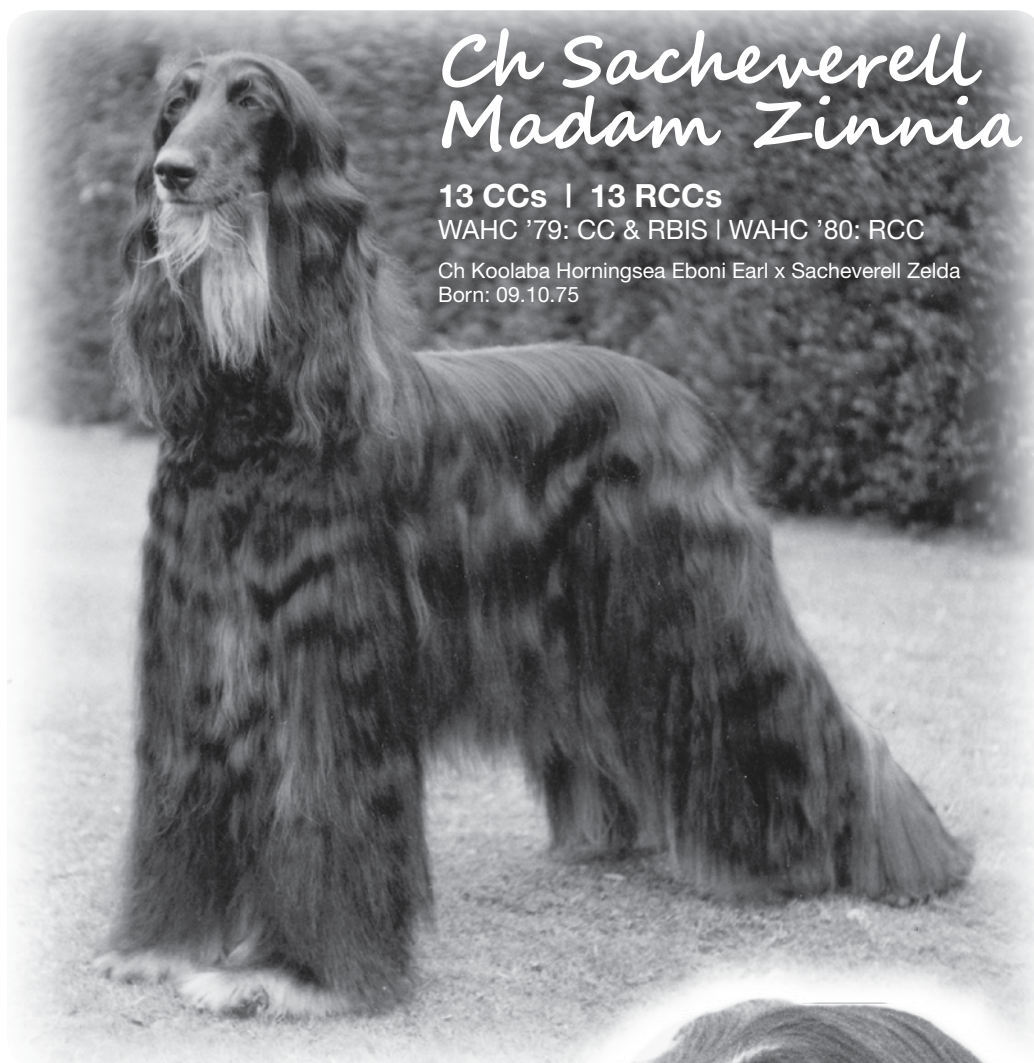

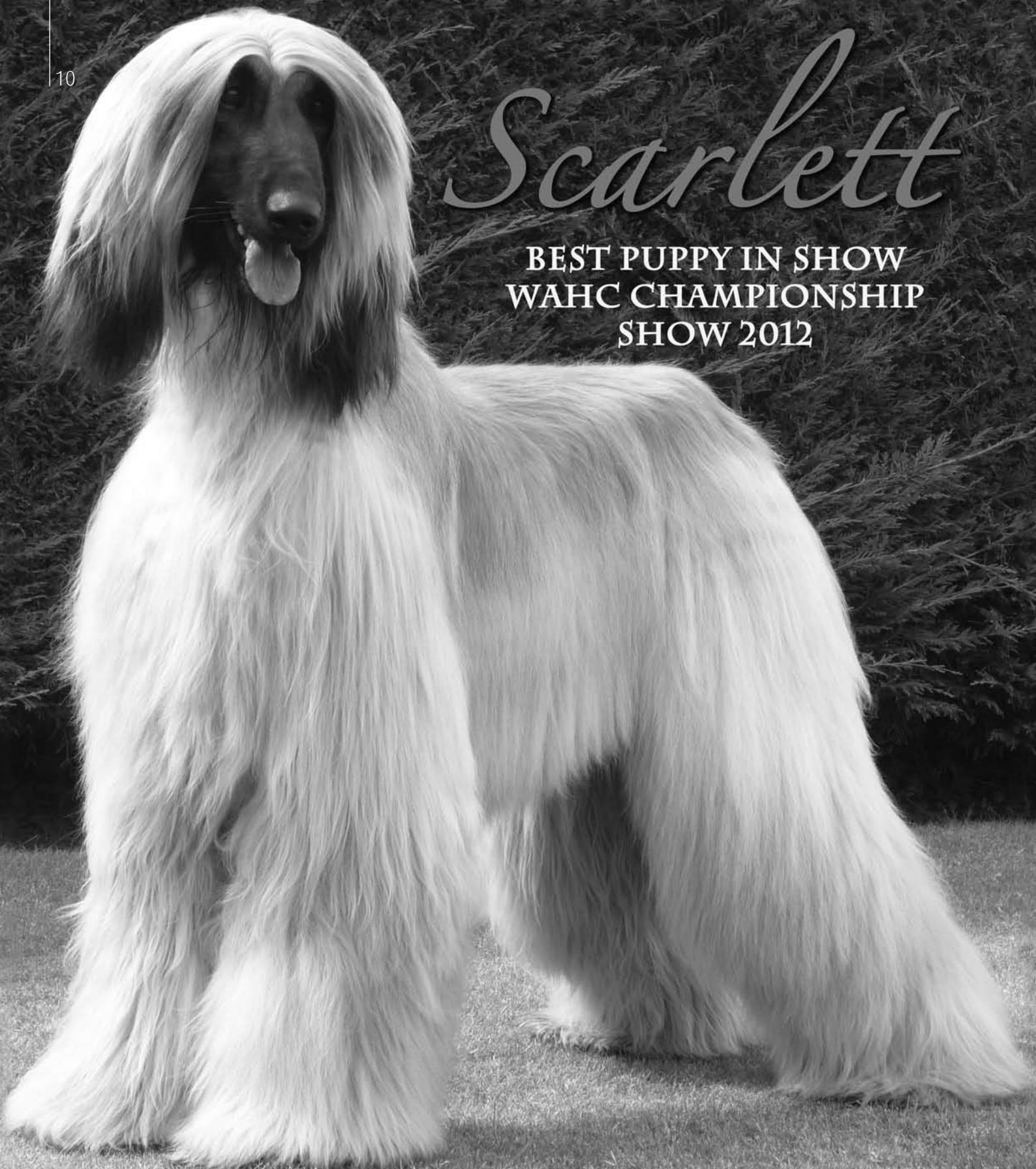

After nursing our dear little cross breed "Sam" for five weeks with distemper we thought we had won the battle – but the worse was to come. He started violently fitting and with two small children in the home we finally had to say a tearful goodbye.

I was lost without my furry companion, Len out most evenings and Melinda (4 years) and Stephen (2.5 years) being in bed early. Our vet explained that provided the dog was fully inoculated we could have another straight away. The following weekend in the 'Kent Messenger' Afghan Hound puppies, fully inoculated were being advertised. Out came 'The Observer Book of Dogs' - oh they look lovely – we will go have a look. That was the start of our long love affair with the Afghan Hound.

We came home from Dover that August Bank Holiday weekend 1967 with 6 month old **Zendushkas Wild Rose of Dywka**. Mrs Hely, her breeder, told us how good she was and she would like her to be shown. Dog shows – what were they? Len and I knew nothing about them! We should have realised that we would never make a show dog of our dear Zena. At 6 months she had never been out of the confines of Mrs Hely's walled garden. She had never been socialised – hiding behind the sofa when Mrs Hely tried to introduce her to us and never had a collar or lead on – but we tried. Zena went everywhere with us. She was part of our family. We found training classes – twice a week, every week to train both her and

me! We had frequent trips to town - Zena on a lead, Stephen on his reins and Melinda toddling along beside us. We were constantly negotiating the shoppers in Woolworths – you could take dogs in with you then.

In 1968 we entered our first show at Chatham Town Hall. Zena was in Junior, needless to say she didn't think a lot of it. We came home cardless. Zena just did not like being on a lead. She went everywhere with Len off the lead, but I did not have the courage. We tried a few more shows then decided we would later breed our own show dog.

Zena was mated to Carole King's black and silver **Ahmed Khan Tujallu** (Ryff). He had recently received a RCC from Marna Dodds. She produced 9 beautiful babies in various shades of gold. We registered her name Zendushkas as our prefix and her progeny were all named after roses. We kept **Zendushkas Milord** and **Zendushkas Lady Zia**. The others were found good homes on the strict understanding that they came back to us if for any reason they needed to be re-homed. That is how we came to buy back **Zendushkas Dazla** at the age of 2 years.

Zena went on to have 2 more litters to **Ch Bondor Dera Gazi Khan** and **Ch Bondor Azim Khan** with several of her progeny gaining their stud book numbers. She ruled the roost in our affie family until the day she died at 16.5 years. Almost all of her family and her extended family bared a couple of white hairs on their muzzles where she had put them in their place as youngsters.

With Lady Zia we began our long and much loved association with the show world. We became members of the Western Afghan Hound Club in August 1969 and attended their first open show at Devizes Town Hall – judged by Charles Harrison (bitches) and Joan Wonnacot (dogs). Len was thrilled to win puppy under Charles Harrison who told

him that "you only get a bitch like that once in a lifetime." I believe he was right.

Lady went on to win our first CC at the age of 19 months under all-rounder Bill Foster and a RCC under Stephanie Hunt-Crowley. She tragically lost a front tooth hitting a chain link fence at full speed. She was always in the cards after that but sadly no more CCs. However, Carole and Dave King took Ryff and his 6 month son – **Zendushkas Desperado** with them when they emigrated to Canada. They both became Canadian champions – So **Zendushkas Desperado** became our first champion. He produced several Canadian champions.

As I said before, the whole family were involved with the dogs. Melinda handled Lady and Stephen handled Milord in some of the first child handling events and they both qualified for the finals at Richmond.



Zena's second litter to **Ch Bondor** **Azim Khan** produced **Zendushkas Golden Sun** who went on to do a lot of winning for Cindy Heal (Tazieff). He was put to Pam Kingsnorth's (ex-kennel maid to Peggy Riley – Bletchingly) bitch and Cindy had back **Gentleman Jim of Tazieff** who became Cindy's first champion. He was used by Alan and Lesley Busby, producing their first champion – **Ch Wilbus Fleur De Lys of Bowentree**, owned and campaigned by Dee Waterman. We retained the only bitch in this litter – **Zendushkas Pixie Gold**. She did some useful winning handled by Len with a pocket full of digestive biscuits. To this day they are known as Pixie Biscuits in this household. She was a great favourite with the children because like her mother she could be trusted off the lead. She would go off for the day across the fields with Melinda and Stephen and their gang – with packed lunches and Bonios and water for Pixie.

From Zena's third litter to **Ch Bondor Dera Ghazi Khan** we retained **Zendushkas Sunsilk**. She was a feisty little red bitch who ruled the roost, but Zena remained head of the household. The first outing of this litter was at Richmond Championship Show, then held in London at Olympia, under Shelia Gilleney. In a very large class the four girls went 1, 2, 3 and VHC – a nice start to their show career. **Zendushkas Sunsilk** was put to **Ch Alyshan Hassan Shabah** and **Zendushkas Silken Saint** became a much loved member of our family. He was a very

impressive black masked gold who did a lot of winning for us and gained his stud book number. He was apparently tipped for the ticket at Birmingham Championship Show under Jo Holden. Whilst I was in a large puppy class with **Zendushkas Pansy** some nasty person made sure that that was not to be. I took an extremely sick dog home that day. It was touch and go if our vet could save him. He was never shown again, he was 12 when we finally had to say goodbye.

When Zena's daughter **Zendushkas Dazla** came home to us she was shown along with Lady Zia and Milord. She gained several BOB and BIS awards and also her stud book number. That was no easy task in those days with 30 – 40 entries in a class. She was mated to **Ch Bondor Azim Khan** and gave us our first UK Champion **Zendushkas**

Dazravi. He was a wonderful red, owned and campaigned by Lyn Mawdoley. Lyn, heavily pregnant, had us all holding our breath when she handled Dazravi to his 3rd CC and BOB under Muriel Harrison at Blackpool. The next day she had her son!

Dazravi's litter brother **Zendushkas Dazwalla** went to Scotland to live with Dr and Mrs Dawson. He was put to their own bitch and a dog from this mating **Khanikush Rakim** was sent to Mr and Mrs Massey-Sikhama and became the top winning dog in South Africa. He sired several South African Champions.

Dazla's second litter to **Montravia Bondor Bolero** produced only one puppy dog – **Zendushkas Beau Dazla** (Bobby). She refused to stay with him in the whelping box after a while – she would feed him, clean him up and then disappear till the next feed. Poor little man, I felt sorry for him on his own, so I popped him in to the large pocket in the front of my apron. I carried him around whilst I did my housework – one contented puppy. Bobby did a lot of winning for us. He gained his first CC under Ivy Atkins at The Southern Afghan Hound Club. Daphne Gie awarded him BIS in a record entry of over 500 dogs. We came home on cloud nine. His second CC came from that great all-rounder Bobby James at Welsh Kennel Club 1981, **Ch Montravia Kaskarak Hitari** winning the RCC. Bobby passed on his excellent conformation and movement to his son **Ch Zendushkas Pekoe**.

Back to Pixie, she was put to **Addington Alexis**, an all-black dog we very much admired. From that litter we kept **Zendushkas Pandora**, our first black and silver. After gaining her stud book number she was put to Marna Dodds new import **Am. Ch Hazzar Excelis of Horningsea**. We had booked to use **Ch Horningsea Survivor**. However, we were invited to a party at Marna's to welcome Celi to the UK upon his release from 6 months quarantine (we were the only couple in the crowded

room that did not give CCs). We fell in love with this happy extrovert and asked if we could use him instead. He became the father of **Ch Zendushkas Pancelli** owned and campaigned by Karen Howard. Celli was a stunning black masked cream. He was an extrovert like his father and sired champions for Keith and Brenda Thorton. We retained **Zendushkas Pansy** who went on to get her JW. Marna Dodds was very impressed with the litter and asked if we would run **Zenduskas Panjon** on for her while she got through the busy season of her boarding kennel. We readily agreed. Tragically at the Southern Counties Show Marna collapsed at the ringside and died later that night in hospital.

Pansy was one of those strange bitches who only came in season once a year. Two years running we tried to mate her to Beau Dazla without success. The third year we let them run together – supervised – of course. They tied on the 7th day – we had been trying too late. Pansy produced 10 bouncing babies 9 weeks later. The mating produced Sandra Woodleys RCC winner **Zendushkas Panther Lily** and our own CC winner **Zendushkas Pathan Daisy** and our super black and tan showman **Ch Zendushkas Pekoe**. He didn't need me in the ring; he knew exactly what the judge wanted. He would stack himself in perfect show stance unaided. In fact if I tried to stack him he looked awful! As soon as the judge uttered the words triangle or whatever he was off with me in tow. He produced two champions for Pauline Mullins and Jill McBride – **Ch Ratheeli Mahzuzh** and **Ch Ratheeli Murshadah**. He won BIS at the

AHA open show – when entries were over 200, three years in succession. First under Fran Frankenburger (Germany), second year under Fuki Yosimoto (Japan) and the third year under Christine Parsell and Cindy Heal. That was also the year we had best puppy in show with **Zendushkas Blue Dawn**, her first show at 6 months and one day. Another trip on cloud nine! I'd give anything to have Pekoe back – how I miss that dog.

His sister **Zendushkas Pathan Daisy** gained a RCC under Mary Davies at the Hound Association Champ Show. Unfortunately this beautiful black masked silver often sporting a black saddle, would shed all her body coat after a season, so was not shown that often. She was put to BIS crufts winner **Ch Montravia Kaskarak Hitari** and produced two oyster brindle boys. **Zendushkas Rue** and **Zendushkas Rubas**. Rubas was a Christmas present for Melinda, who was duly wrapped up in Christmas paper. She trained and campaigned him and he won well – gaining a RCC. Daisy was also mother to **Zenduskas Wild Roses** owned in partnership with Gail Link who gained 2RCCs.

Joy Carter brought a lovely bitch – **Firemont Azida** a daughter of Pekoe to be mated to **Zendushkas Rubas**. We kept **Regal Lilly of Zendushkas** who was owned in partnership with Suzanne Bartolo. Lilly gained 9 RCCs before finally getting her 3rd CC.

Our blue line started in 1972 when we had an excited phone call from Cindy Heal to say she had a blue bitch she had just whelped from a litter by **Black Rock of Zendushkas**



out of **Tazieff Gollywog**. **Black Rock of Zendushkas** was a solid black (bred by Pauline Mullins and Jill McBride out of **Zendushkas Peridot**, Pandora's sister, and the golden **Kingsleah Khan of Khanabad**). **Tazieff Gollywog** was black and tan. Len traced the breeding back and the only blue on both sides of the pedigree was eight generations back. Cindy was unable to keep a bitch at that time so Purdy - **Tazieff Trinket of Zendushkas** became part of our family. We attended very few shows that year as Len lost his job and was out of work for ten months. Good job we had chickens, it's surprising how many dishes you can make with eggs. My parents said that the

Afghans had to go – no way and they still had their Purina.

Later, once we were on our feet again Purdy was put to **Ch Bluestone Rocket of Zudiki** and we kept **Zendushkas Blue Flint** from that litter and his sister **Zendushkas Sapphire**. Daphne Gie had a lovely white called **Zendushkas Sardon**. Flint gained his JW and went on to get a CC and BOB at Windsor. Shortly after that we had problems again and all our dogs were kennelled with Sue Collier for six months. Melinda and I went every day to exercise them until we moved to the Midlands with 11 Afghans and 2 ponies. After that Flint didn't want to know showing.

Flint's sister Sapphire was put to Ann Allan's **Kabella The Blues Singer** and whelped 12 lovely babies – 3 white dogs, 3 white bitches, 1 blue dogs, 3 blue bitches, 1 blue

domino and one black and blue bitch. The next few weeks were hectic, first bottle feed at 6am and last bottle midnight. Sapphire was super mum and together we raised 12 healthy puppies. Those that were shown did extremely well in the ring. **Zendushkas Blue Dawn** and **Zendushkas Blue Mist** gaining their JW and **Zendushkas Snowstorm** going BPIS at the Southern Open Show and as mentioned earlier, **Blue Dawn** BPIS at AHA.

Later once we had established ourselves in

the Midlands at Wild Rose Kennels she was mated to **Zendushkas Rubas** producing a blue bitch **Zendushkas Samphire**, a silver/blue brindle dog **Zendushkas Silver Ghost** – used with some success by Ken Sinclair. **Zendushkas Samphire** went to Jean Austin on breeding terms; she was mated to to **Am Ch Trinitys Backdraft Paladin to Freecloud** imported by Mark Cocozza. The

puppy we chose to live with us was the blue – **Sparkling Soda of Zendushkas**. What a live wire he was, the day after a show I was black and blue on my arm. Like Pekoe, he always stacked himself and moved like a dream, taking 4 strides to everyone's 6. He went best puppy at Crufts, gained his JW and was the first blue champion in England for 25 years. He came out of retirement at the age of 10 and a half and won 7 best veterans in show in 12 months. He sired 3 champions: Sue Green's **Ch Sochera's The Enchantment at Sanchera JW ShCM**, our own **Ch Soda Pop of Zendushkas JW** and Ann Allan's **SA Ch Kabella Wild Blue Yonder**. He also sired **Spring Heeled Jack of Zendushkas JW** owned in partnership with Gabrielle Pond Baker who gained 2RCCs.

In 1997, Len decided that we were too old to have any more litters so we kept the line going by having a puppy back in lieu of stud fee. I'm afraid that I went against Len's wishes in 2008 and Melinda and I took our lovely **Ch Soda Pop of Zendushkas JW** to visit Jeff and Heather handsome gold boy **Ch Sashkan Gold Dhust at Zadal JW**. It was love at first sight and Poppy produced 10 bouncing babies. Those shown have made their mark in the ring, **Zendushkas Whiskey Galore JW** owned by Sue Green and our own **Zendushkas Sparkling Rosé** gaining RCCs. That was our first litter in 11 years; I had forgotten what hard work it was helping out Poppy with bottle feeding, assisted by Claire Parker and Melinda.

Both Len and I have tried to help the breed and dogs in general over the years, Len being rescue officer for the Southern, then Secretary, then Chairman and then on to be Chairman of the Breed Council. I served 16 years on the Gravesend and Medway committee running their ring craft classes for the last 6 years before we moved to the Midlands.

The last 46 years have not been all good, probably more "downs" than "ups" but we managed to keep our Affie family together and I have not regretted any of it. Before the children and the Afghans Len and I were racing cyclists and there was a saying – "When you hit the pain barrier don't give up, try even harder and you will ride out the other side" – and we did!!

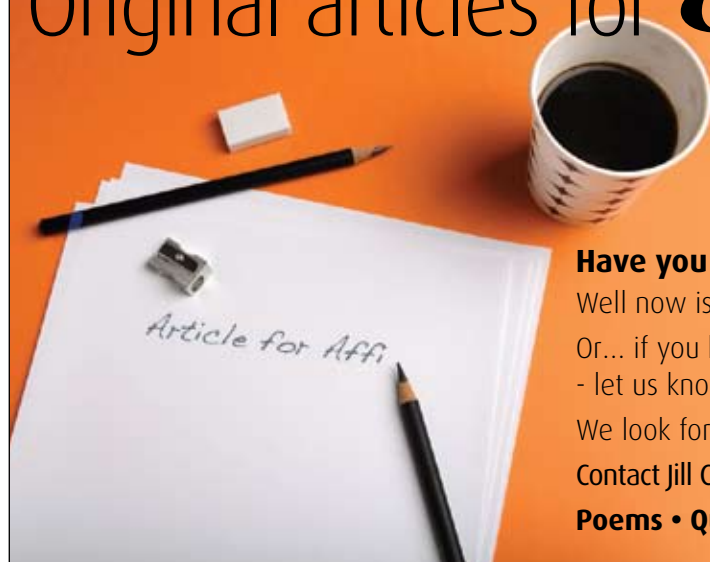

The following requirements apply to entries for these awards:

1. Breeders wishing to enter the competition should first purchase a Breeders Competition Record Book from the Kennel Club or from the show secretary.
2. The Breeder enters for the award in his/her name and is responsible for arranging which exhibits form their breeder group, or team.
3. The Breeder must complete the Record Book accurately with all necessary details before presenting it to the show organisers.
4. The Breeder is responsible for obtaining the necessary authority to compete from the show organisers (or designated official such as the Ring Steward) to compete for the award.
5. The Breeder's team must consist of a minimum of three and a maximum of four dogs of the same breed, all of which must be entered in a class at the show.
6. A Breeder may enter more than one team per show.
7. All dogs must have the same registered breeder.
8. The 'beaten dog' rule will NOT apply.
9. Best Breeder in Breed and Best Breeder in AVNSC Classes goes through to a Best Breeder in Group award.
10. Breeders acquire points in competition over a calendar year as follows:

Best Breeder in Breed/AVNSC Classes	3 points
Second place Breeder in Breed/AVNSC Classes	2 points
Third place Breeder in Breed/AVNSC Classes	1 point
Best Breeder in Group	4 points
Second place Breeder in Group	3 points
Third place Breeder in Group	2 points
Fourth place Breeder in Group	1 point

The Breeders who have amassed a minimum of 25 points over a calendar year will qualify for the Final/Semi-Final in the following year. It is not a requirement to withdraw from the competition upon reaching 25 points. At the end of the competition year in question, Breeders should forward their record books to the Canine Activities Department at the Kennel Club which will advise whether they have qualified for the Crufts Final.

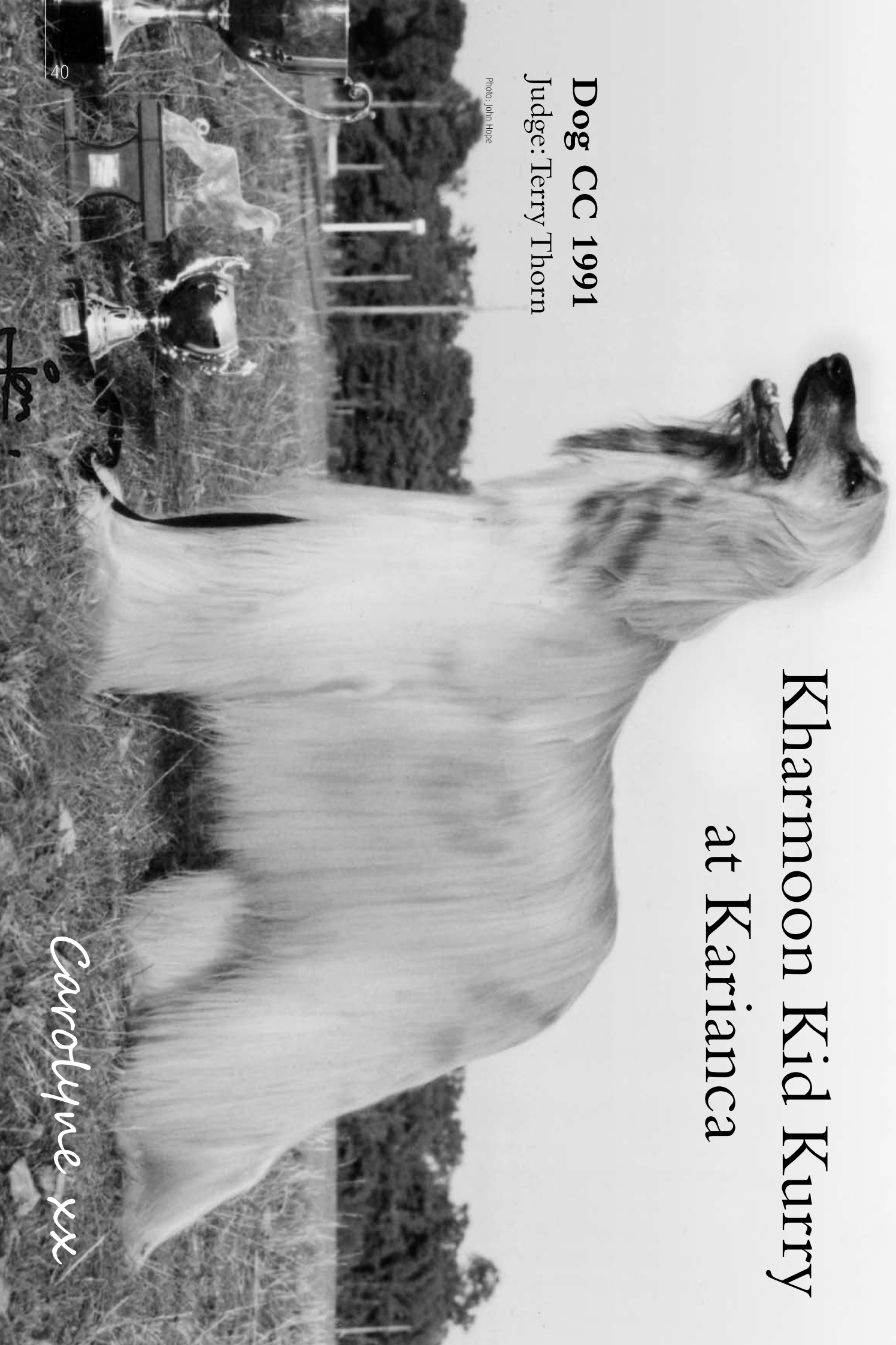

In 1970 I was asked to give a home to an Afghan Hound bitch. At the time I didn't even know what an Afghan was – I was soon, however, to find out! She came during the Christmas weekend and stayed in our lives for 13 years until she died. Her name was Tasha and she was the last of the Bletchingly line. Her sire was **Mohamad Ali of Kushra**; her dam was **Bletchingley Katrianna**. As we were living at the time at Bowen Farm in Sussex, she was registered as **Lemarc's Natasha of Bowentree**.

My children were still quite young at this time, so my attendance at shows was limited. Nevertheless, I embarked on the circuit in England as an enthusiastic novice, picking up what I could from people who had been in the dog world for many years. As time progressed and my knowledge increased, I became convinced that the Bletchingley and Carloway lines were two of the most important links in the history of the Afghan Hound and, by now a committed Afghan disciple, made the decision to try and continue, and if possible, improve on these magnificent strains.

After long deliberation over the stud books, Tasha was mated to **Xanaghan Sasha** and produced a litter of 10 puppies. Several of these went on to do well in the show ring and one daughter, **Bowentree Anastasia** (owned by Tricia Robey), in turn went to **Amudarya Shura** (owned by Sylvia Evans). Once again 10 puppies were produced of which a few went on to be shown. I retained a bitch, **Kalinka of Bowentree**; Alan and Lesley Busby acquired **Tatiana of Bowentree at Wilbus**; Sylvia Evans retained a dog **Alexeiev from Amshura** and others also went on to be shown. Tatiana was mated to **Ch Gentleman Jim from Tazieff** which produced the marvellous Wilbus F litter, most notably **Ch Fleur de Lys**, **Fantasia** and **Ferstinlyne**. Then Kalinka, was given to Sylvia Evans following the loss of one of her

bitches and was in turn put to **Amudarya Shafi**. This mating provided the beginnings of today's Amshura line.

My beloved Fleur was mated to **Shulimar Super Trouper at Tazieff**. Six puppies were born who all went on to win well in the ring. **Bowentree Orka at Japapa** sired litters at both Melleck and Chazis. **Bowentree Vladimir of Baldakhan** was mated to **Zara of Bowentree** which it turn produced 10 puppies. One was **Shallimar** who in time was mated back to **Bowentree Soffia**. Another was Dawn Russell's **Bowentree Sucher at Rusmar**, who was mated to **Ch Melleck Hitchiker** (an Orka son) to produce **Rusmar Arpage for Bowentree** who I owned in partnership with David Evans and Brian Hillier. Page won a CC and RCC but unfortunately lost her front teeth to gum disease, so was retired from the showing. Together this partnership continued with **Ch Wilbus Lovesong JW**, who had many lovely wins throughout her long life.

There have been other dogs over the years, all of them beloved and all of them 'family'. I have been very fortunate with their owners, many of whom have gone on to become firm friends, with a mutual interest in maintaining the quality of the lines started by Tasha over 40 years ago. Now with the benefit of age and hopefully, some small knowledge of the breed, much of my time is taken up with judging. I am a member of the KC and I was honoured to be appointed Vice-Chairman of the breed Council – a post I held for many years. I was also a member of the Southern Afghan Club committee for many years.

I judged dogs at Crufts in 2007. The last few years due to domestic circumstances, my breeding and showing has been curtailed. However my interest has never waned. I look forward to judging at your Western show in January 2014.

October AM Colin Dann

My involvement in Afghan hounds goes back to the early seventies, when Debbie, my wife and I took ownership of **Kyzyl's Kudu**. We had lots of fun showing and then decided get more involved.

This took us down the path of having a bitch who did not like showing but produced a litter and was a great Mum. Also at that time our daughter Catherine at about the age of 8 started showing **Alderaan's Princess of Wales** and achieved a stud book entry.

During that time I became involved in the Southern Afghan Club and was Show Manager and Vice Chairman for a number of years. Successfully passed the judging exam in 1984 and gradually progressed to be able

to judge at CC level at WELKS, SAC and East of England.

I retired early from BT and decided to look for a puppy, as a family we agreed on the breeding we liked and then waited for a litter and chose **Amudarya Shubad**, a gold brindle. 'Bethany' was shown mainly by Catherine and eventually became a Champion winning 4 CCs and 3 RCCs, including BIS at the Western AHC Champ Show in 2001.

As a family we have also been involved with Skye Terriers and I was privileged this year to Judge the breed at Crufts at which my BOB went on to win the Terrier Group and challenge for BIS.



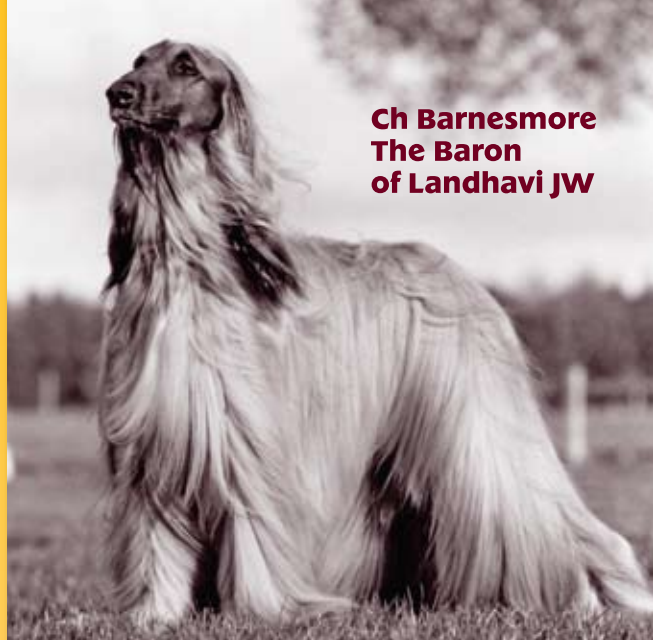
October PM Elaine Wyatt

Ownership included **Ch Lissue Storm Cloud** (born 1981) and her half sister **Ch Lissue As You Like It** (born 1982). Later came litter sisters born 1999: **Ch Arushkhan Thunder Storm from Bellapais** (jointly owned with Valerie West and Lynn Young) and **Storm In A Teacup at Bellapais** – 2CCs, (also jointly owned with Valerie).

In 1992, Elaine, her husband Mike and Carol Bustin bred a litter from **Weetoneon Dark 'N' Devoted** by Lynn's **Ch Karaburan Pretty Boy Floyd at Shirobana**, this produced their own **Ch Bellapais Touché Turtle**. In 2000 another litter was produced in partnership with Noel Stokes (Kimani), which produced the successful brindle dog **Ch Bellapais Kimani Hrrhaluke at Shirobana** owned by Lynn Young. This dog is one of only two that have been BIS at the Western AHC Championship Shows twice and can be found behind many Afghans that are in the showing today.

Elaine withdrew from exhibiting many years ago but still retains an interest and can often be seen at the ringside.

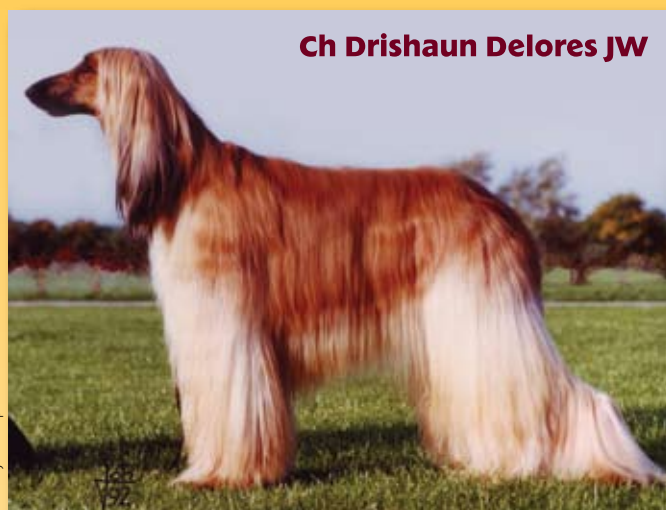

Bletchingley

We have been asked to write this piece about our interest and admiration of the Bletchingley Afghan Hounds.

Where to start? Well first we must declare an undying passion for the history of our breed, so that makes it easier! In 2005 David was asked to write a piece for the WAHC 'Affi' Magazine on Marion Newitt's Kamiren Afghans, as David had owned and shown the beautiful 'Blue' otherwise known as **Kamiren Ambroisine** and 'Bubbles' otherwise known as **Kamiren Araminta**. Marion's hilarious article about travelling with Terry and Shirley Carr to show in Northern Ireland was reprinted from 1975 when **Ch Mucmul Gee of Jabigandal** (Bully) won his crowning CC. Remembering those days and committing it to paper was great fun, fascinating and rewarding all at the same time. There must be so many other folks in the Afghan world with great stories to tell, how their lines came about, how certain matings were planned (or not!) and what fun was had on the way, it would be brilliant if they could be written down and preserved.

A few years ago, when David was enjoying a landmark birthday, Margaret and Tony Greening made it known to us that their daughter Charlotte was friendly with the niece of one Peggy Riley of the Bletchingley Afghan Hounds. Peggy's niece had one of Peggy's Afghan Hound photo albums and wanted it to go to someone with an interest in the breed. Margaret and Tony very kindly bought the album for David for his birthday.

The album has been lovingly put together, with tissue pages between each page. Some of the pictures are missing, and we

believe that this is because they were used in the press, who didn't return them, and some were possibly used for Margaret Niblock's book, **The Afghan Hound – A Definitive Study**.

This is where it is right to start, and we make no apology for re-printing in full the Bletchingley paragraphs from Chapter 12 of Margaret Niblock's book **The Afghan Hound – A Definitive Study**:

Bletchingley – The first to join the ranks in 1942 was Mrs Peggy Riley, adding Afghans to her Bletchingley kennel of Cocker. Choosing Chaman foundation stock, she acquired the proven broods **Ravelly Badrea** (Ch Firdausi of Geufon x Ghanistan Zarifa), and **Shiba of Chaman** (Ch Westmill Bayezid Ansari x Safiya). By mating **Shiba** to **Taj Ameer of Chaman** Mrs Riley bred her first champion, **Bletchingley Tajomeer**. The first of many Bletchingley champions, his type was to successfully dominate may subsequent breeding programmes, particularly through his female get. A tall black-masked red, **Ch Tajomeer** inherited the houndy Bell-Murray outline, long fine

head, ring tail and their coat pattern of deep saddle and bare pasterns. He had a delightful, friendly temperament; like all the hounds of this type he was slow to mature, finally winning his title in 1949. He sired two champions x **Ravelly Badrea**, Mr Reg Floyd's **Ch Bletchingley El Bazra of Ravelly**, a houndy red dog, the bitches Shechar and Sancha and their famous, top-winning litter sister **Ch Bletchingley Zara**, born April 1947 and described by Mr Lewis Renwick as 'A good honest type, moves well, sound everywhere'.

Ravelly Badrea had the sound conformation and beautiful head of her sire **Ch Firdausi of Geufon**. A repeat mating in 1948 produced **Ch Bletchingley Tribesman**, a tall and handsome masked cream, similar in outline to his sire, but a difficult dog to handle. Probably through lack of socialisation he was nervous and apprehensive in the ring. After gaining his title at Crufts in 1951 he was retired to stud, where he sired Mrs Frank's **Ch Bletchingley Tola-Na-Ha** (a Kohistan

Shahudin granddaughter) and other CC winners, but died shortly afterwards. Still using **Ch Tajomeer** and **Badrea**, Mrs Riley produced a female line renowned for their health and natural whelping ability, devoid of inherited whelping troubles. These included **Bletchingley Shecar**, behind the Tarjih champions bred by Miss Pauline Leyder, and Dr Porter's **Ch Bletchingley Bedra el Kabul**, and from the bitches Sancha, and Lorette (bred by Miss Ide), behind the Khanabads.

NB **Ch Bletchingley Tola-Na-Ha** is sometimes listed as **Ch Bletchingley Tola-Na-Ra** or **Tola-Na-Ka**.

Peggy Riley went on to breed many successful Afghan Hounds and export several to USA, Australia, New Zealand, France and India. She bred 13 UK Champions who were crowned between 1949 and 1973. There are 162 Bletchingley Afghans listed on pawvillage.com and Pedigree Plus. Not all are bred by Peggy, but most are, and it is curious to see that some litters were registered as bred by her in partnership with Marie Ray in Australia long after Peggy had passed away. We

guess they didn't get around to changing the registration! Peggy's breeding survives in lines around today, and just to throw some recent names into the ring (so to speak) and not meaning to favour anyone individual or dog, look at the pedigrees of the following UK Champions – **Ch Saxonmill Jennyanydots**, **Ch Amudarya Shalar**, **Ch Gentleman Jim from Tazieff**, **Ch Gardwright Legend**, **Ch Cloudside Love Games**, **Ch Bellapais Touche Turtle**, **Ch Arushkhan Raising A Storm**, or even **Ch Tulak Risky Business at Wilbus JW** and you will be able to find the Bletchingley line, even if only a little bit! Remember, from tiny acorns...

How I became Shirley Carr's 'WebMaster'

It's a great title, isn't it? This article was inspired following a conversation with an old friend at the recent celebration of Shirley's life.

Shirley's tragically swift passing meant it was time to get the old telephone directory out and call up the troops for her final parade. It was very casually at the end of the day, as we were leaving The Lansdowne in Derry Hill, Wiltshire that I was button-holed and complimented on my efforts with Shirley's Afghan Hound Rescue website. **www.afghanhoundrescue.co.uk** Thank you very much! But since Shirley's sudden passing, I have not enjoyed good health and had time to sit and reflect on how it all came about, for I am no computer whizz. In fact, I am completely self-taught, and the only course I have ever been on that proved to be invaluable for this task was a "How to use Microsoft Word" course over 20 years ago, paid for by my employer. I got to thinking how on earth it had all come about. It is possible that the jobs I have had over the past 40 years have steered me in this direction?

forty years ago

I started my working life at age 16 with a firm of local solicitors who had three branches, in Swindon, Wootton Bassett and Calne. The "Calne" connection will reoccur. As I had just left school, I was taught everything about working in the office. I was lucky that one of my five O'Levels from school was typing – I was one of only three boys who took it in my year and I have never been out of work because I did so. Forty years ago we did not have computers and software, but typists and carbon paper! Our biggest tranche of work was Conveyancing, the transfer of ownership of property and land. Now, I understand, most of the UK's title to land is registered at HM Land Registry and certificates are issued with the current owner's names on. Back then in the seventies, land titles were proven by historical Title Deeds, some going back hundreds of years. When a property, or piece of property, changed hands at the time I worked for the solicitors, draft documents were typed up first (often several times) and then finally typed (engrossed) without allowing for a single error onto parchment and linen documents called Conveyances. If a plan or map was required, my schoolboy Technical Drawing skills came in very handy and the office girls sewed them into the document by hand, for I was rubbish at that!

infrastructure

I left there after three years to go on a big adventure and work in Saudi Arabia, and, of course, earn good money! My typing skills got me the job after an interview and typing test at an employment agency in Kensington High Street, and although I did not know it at the time, I was hired to work for the Bechtel group of companies, a major world-wide civil engineering firm, which was in the process of helping Saudi Arabia build cities and an industrial infrastructure for when the oil runs out (perhaps with hind-sight we should say "if" the oil runs out!). This was the mid-1970s and I was only 19 years old. Later they placed age restrictions when granting work visas for Saudi Arabia, but I got away with it. Again because of my typing skills, I was assigned to the Contracts Department at the site offices in Al Khobar, Saudi Arabia. I flew out there on my own, never having left the UK before, on a flight to Rome, and changed there at Leonardo da Vinci Airport for my onward flight to Dhahran, Saudi Arabia. There were no direct flights to Saudi Arabia in 1976. My work involved typing the draft and final contracts which were awarded by our client, The Royal Commission for Jubail and Yanbu, to international construction firms to build this, move that or design something else. Once again no mistakes were allowed, as every contract had to be translated and typed into Arabic, fortunately not by me. I also can honestly say that I typed every English word of a 50-volume Purchasing and Contracting Manual which we then had translated into Arabic and typed, and as



we were back in the dark ages then, three of us spent days, hours and weeks photocopying it and binding it by hand for the client. Just as we finished (!), IBM arrived and brought with them the IBM Mag Card II Selectric Typewriter, a revolutionary electric typewriter with a memory! This reduced the need for lots of typists, and meant that once a document was finished and approved by the client it was "banked" and stored on magnetic cards, pre-cursor to the floppy disk. I was sent to St John's Wood in London to the IBM College there to learn all about it, and train my colleagues in the use of it when I returned. I did this for about six months, then returned to the UK after two years.

Upon my return, I used my contacts made in Saudi Arabia to wangle myself a job in Bechtel's London Office, and worked in Fulham (actually Putney Bridge) and Hammersmith for a few years. The work here was very different from that on site, and was at that time mostly concerned with the design of North Sea Oil Rigs. I was assigned to one for the Mobil Oil Company for the Beryl North Sea Oil Field, and our rig was called Beryl B. I am proud to say she is still out there and operational, but not now owned by ExxonMobil.

drinks party

As you will guess, I had not a Scooby-Doo how to design an oil rig, but my work involved production control and record-keeping, which was fascinating. The Chief Engineer set the design schedule and it was my job to ensure it was met. Our Project was funded by progress payments, so if it hadn't happened, we didn't get paid. Of course it happened, and at 80% complete Mobil gave us a budget to splurge on a drinks party for everyone on the project, of which there were hundreds of designers, engineers, draughtsmen and women, clerks and secretaries. An Australian colleague and I were tasked with organising the event, so we hired the bar and lobby of The Lyric Theatre, Hammersmith and paid over the money. We were both smart enough to stand well back when the bar opened!

personnel department

I went back to Saudi Arabia again after this, but with a different company. I had by then bought a house in High Wycombe, Buckinghamshire and the mortgage rate in the early 1980s was crippling, 15% I believe. I had to choose between selling the house or going to Saudi Arabia. This time I went to a different Agency, and they again checked my typing! I was sent to the opposite side of Saudi Arabia to where I had been before, up in the Asir Mountains, to an airbase in a place called Khamis Mushayt not too far from the Yemen border. Here I was assigned to the Personnel Department. Everyone knows what you mean when you use that term, don't they? The Project was to help the Royal Saudi Air Force become self-sufficient at running its airbase there. The company I worked for was called Northrop Corporation, and it made and sold fighter aircraft, primarily at that time the F-5. The United States Air Force were involved with the training of the pilots, and we trained the RSAF to do everything else, including provide support services, fire service, medical service, transportation and so on. I started off typing away for the Personnel Manager, and soon found that he and his senior staff were "contracts up" and heading home. Four or five officers were replaced by a retired USAF Colonel, his best-mate and me! I had to learn fast on this job, and again it had to be very precise. I started organising all of the base staff paper records, which had been filed using three different systems, none of which complied with company policy. Having achieved that in about six months, I moved rooms and found that there was some sort of computerised record-keeping system and method of reporting hires and fires, but that it had been so badly misunderstood by the previous incumbent that everyone had the same Manpower Authorisation number, and so the statistics on the final page were always "1". We had one computer terminal on site, not in my room, and so I began the painstaking task of assigning a unique Manpower Authorisation number to each individual employee by hand and having the computer operator input them to the system, and "Eureka!" got the damned thing to balance. Little did I know that this work had been observed from Headquarters, and I was commended for it and offered a very nice job some years later on the back of it. This was really my first experience of computers, and again it was self-taught.

Back to the UK again after 2.5 years, sold the house in Buckinghamshire by then and moved back to Swindon to bump into one David Evans. I had a small ground-floor flat in West Swindon then, so along came David, later the cat, and later still our first Afghan Hound – a rescue from Shirley called Channelle. I bet you thought I would never get this back on track, didn't you?

Nearly thirty years ago now, David helped

me get employment upon my return from Saudi Arabia with the then Department for Employment. We calculated and paid out unemployment benefit with the help of some very primitive (at the time) computer systems. I have been promoted a couple of times, and worked in Swindon, Marylebone, Westminster, Reading and Basingstoke. Whilst working in Reading and Basingstoke my job was to make decisions on doubtful claims to benefit. When I started there, they had just put in place a computerised decision-making system and banished the typists, never to be seen again. So my typing skills were called for again, and it was at this job that they sent me for a week to Camberley in Surrey to learn Microsoft Word. Best week's training I have ever had.

floating in space

Way back in the year 2000, or thereabouts, this intranet-thingummy-bob started getting global, and ordinary folk could put up a "website" on the "internet", "hosted by an Internet Service Provider." I wanted to build a website for NUMA AFGHAN HOUNDS, and so I did, using just words and pictures and good old Microsoft Word. I found a simple computer program that could convert these documents into the language of the internet, Hypertext Mark-up Language or HTML. Believe me, that is the sum of my knowledge of HTML! By some means or other, I "uploaded" the HTML pages through my ISP to the internet, where they are to this day, floating in space. David and I were so excited about our new website that we had to get someone else to look at it, and so as Shirley and Terry had just recently been connected to the internet, we asked Shirley to tell us what she thought of it. And she did! Blunt is probably the politest adjective that comes to mind! I had to make corrections! Oh heck, how do you do that? Somehow I muddled through. When completed to everyone's satisfaction(!), I could not have known what was coming next. Yes,

Shirley wanted me to make not one, but two websites for her – one for Bozwood and one for Afghan Rescue. The Bozwood site never did get started, but every now and again Shirley would either give me scraps of paper with articles on, plus the odd decaying photograph if I was lucky and sometimes they might even be labelled with who was on them! Later, as she became more computer proficient, and she was self-taught too, she would email me with photos, sometimes they would come through, sometimes not, and most often they would need quite a bit of work to make them look nice on the net. I had to teach myself digital photo-editing! Shirley allowed me carte-blanc to design her Afghan Hound Rescue web pages the way I saw fit, so I resorted to good old Microsoft Word on her site too, but later discovered Microsoft FrontPage, which worked like Microsoft Word but was a bit more technical and you did not need to convert the pages after they were finished. The pages kept coming, and I needed to learn about Navigation Buttons to get from page to page on the internet, and also Photo Galleries to present lots of pictures together on one page without much written narrative. The Afghan Hound Rescue website now consists of 25 pages, and although there are some bugs in there that I cannot seem to fix, in the main everything works and it is very low maintenance. I have to say though, that quite a few tears were shed by me when compiling some of the pages – Rescue is a gut-wrenching business and I for one was glad that my involvement was away from the frontline. You need to be a special person to deal with some people's inhumanity to animals.

old-fashioned

I have upgraded my computer over the years, but still have to have an old-fashioned keyboard. Once something went wrong on one of them and I needed a part for it. When Shirley found out, she immediately said "get what you need and Rescue will pay for it". It was only a £30 printed circuit board, but it was so nice of her to say that, at the time we had no idea how much it would cost to fix.

To build a website you need the skills of a typist, a graphic artist, good quality photographs that are not too big and to plan it out – the back of an envelope is good for this. You need to be very organised, document what you are doing and back it up monthly, whether you have made changes to it or not. You need to be able to make corrections occasionally!

I would like to end this by once again paying tribute to the late Shirley Carr. Her faith in me to be able to build her a website for Afghan Rescue has made me the WebMaster I am today. Below is a picture of Fagin – he heads up the Afghan Hound Rescue website.

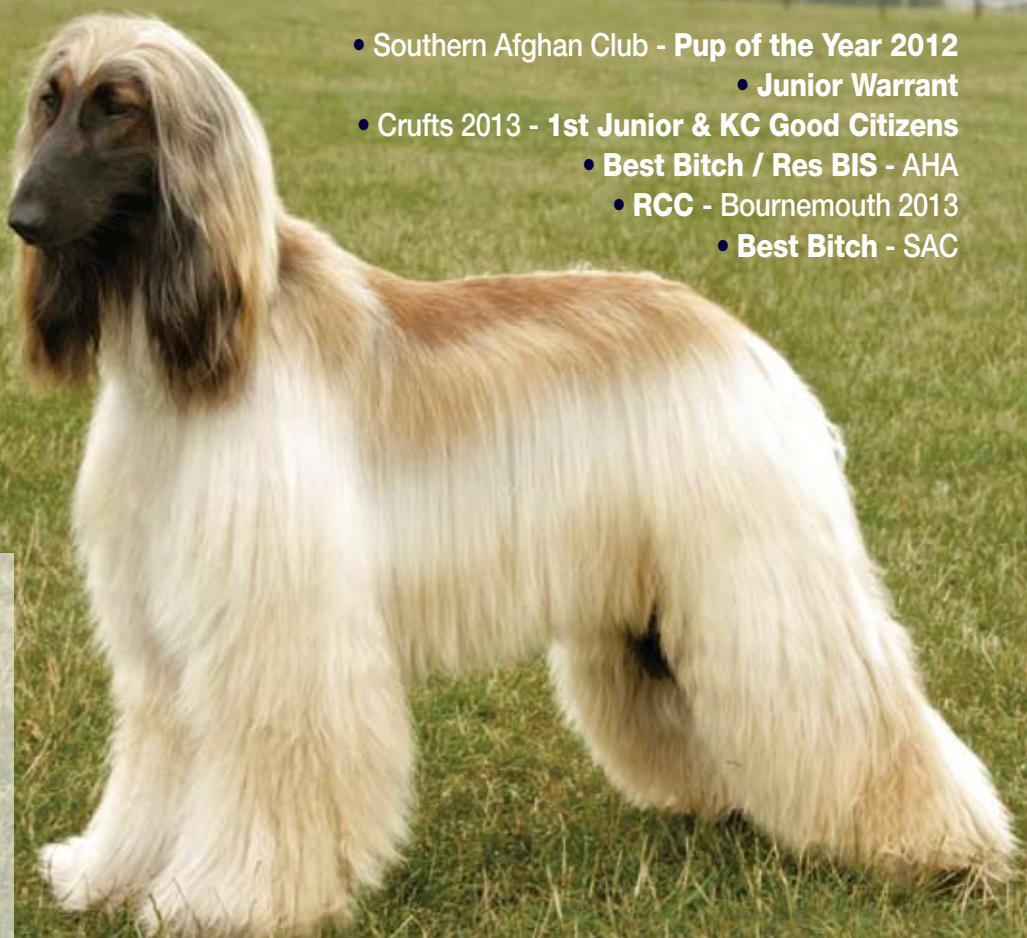

Ruby's Reminiscences – 40 Years of the WAHC

Hi, my name is RUBY (Ch Zandahar Treacle Tart JW ShCM) and I would like to share with you how I got my name in celebration of the 40th Anniversary of the WAHC.

I live with my breeder, Glenda, who adores me, and Dave, who does like me but favours my best friend, Elle, who is a Deerhound. She is better behaved than me, as I can be a bit of a rebel. Sometimes I just like taking off in the field and behaving like most Afghans, and just keep running, even when I know I am being called. Elle gets sent to bring me back and I usually give in as the titbits seem inviting!

perfect name

Glenda and Dave, after several attempts and trying to find the perfect name for me, (mostly it was little Devil or Bugger!), decided on Ruby as I was born in March 2007 the same month as their Ruby Wedding Anniversary. Also it suited me as I had red stripes; it was also 40 years ago that they bought their first Afghan, Sara. Glenda was working in London at the L'Oreal School of Hairdressing as an instructress and one of the models had two Afghans who had mated! The bitch was called **Rifka's Yaslaq D'rar** and was litter sister to the famous Rifka Champion twins, and the sire was **Saladdin of Isfahan** by **Ajman Branwen Kandahar**. From the litter of 10, Glenda and Dave picked the smallest black masked bitch who was just adorable: **Zebedee Siah Posh**. Sara lived to be 17 and had one litter by **Kasper's Alyshan Arabi Pasha**, and was Great-Grandmother of Chris and Julie Amoo's **Ch Viscount Grant** (Crufts BIS winner 1987).

Cleo Laine

They then bought a second black and cream puppy, **Khaspar's Sujata** and called her Cleo, because Dave was a fan of Cleo Laine. Cleo had two litters and they showed and bred lightly for several years. In the litter before they had me (20 years ago), **Ashihna Rosanna for Zandahar** was mated to **Ch Koolaba Alexander of Sacheverell**, and she produced **Ch Zandahar Shadow Play**, **Zandahar Pineapple Poll** and **Zandahar Elite Syncopation**; the repeat mating also produced show winners.

A change of job resulted in Glenda and Dave moving to Bristol in 1967 along with Sara. They didn't know any other Afghan folk in the area but Glenda was keen to learn all she could about grooming and found Dawn Sams very helpful. In those days, the only equipment used was a Mason Pearson

brush; I have heard them telling friends how they went to their first dog show with Sara and won first, this got them hooked and they have been showing ever since.

They soon got to know other enthusiasts and attended the inaugural meeting of the WAHC held at the Pump Rooms in Bath, and they became founder members of the Club, serving on the Committee for many years with Dave eventually becoming its Chairman over a fifteen year period, he is now one of the Vice-Presidents and is an Honorary Life Member.

Afghans were very popular in the early '70s and the Open Shows attracted as many entries as we now have at our Championship Shows, however this had a derogatory effect and led to the Club having to form a Rescue Scheme, which the late Shirley Carr took care of so well, finding homes for so many. We have a lot to thank her for.

Glenda and Dave were

delighted to see how the Club grew, and it gained Championship status with the first such show being held at Hereford. Venues for the show changed along the way ranging from Bristol, Newton Abbott, Malvern, Shepton Mallet, Weston-super-Mare and now back to Bristol. They talked about many memories when the WAHC

regularly held BBQs, those famous rallies and skittle evenings, lots of fun and friendships were born from these events which were more often than not either at Bozwood, the home of Terry and the late Shirley Carr, down to Bude to the late Joan Wonnacott's famous Isfahan Kennels, and across to Jenny Hicks' Nuree Kennels.

Although some of these lifelong friends may no longer have Afghans they still share the same common interest; many are sadly no longer with us – Chris Mahn who designed the original WAHC Logo which appeared on the prize cards, Bryan and Denise Courtney, Chris Robins, Margaret Wilcox, Gaynor Chilton, Annette Wilkinson, Shirley Carr, Margaret Pickard, John and Joan Bland (John being the first Chairman of the Club) and of course John Conibear, who served as Secretary for many, many years.

over the moon

Glenda was delighted to produce a litter from my Mum, **Kulute Jaeger among Zandahar**, and my Dad is **Tulak Usual Suspect** (bred by Val McCormack - now Cummings) and they were just over the moon with the success I had from my very first show, and then gaining Afghan Puppy of the Year in 2007 in just 3 months! My Junior Warrant soon followed as did my Show Certificate of Merit, then to everyone's delight and pride, I got my Champion title at just over two years of age, altogether I have four CCs and now just come to the shows on the odd occasion.

I have now fulfilled Glenda's ambition and have produced a litter to **Ch Sitana Jaranwala at Tulak JW**, and had one beautiful bitch puppy and her name is Lily. She will make her debut at this 40th Anniversary Show – how fitting is that! Lily was named after the Easter Lily because she was born at Easter, and her official pedigree name is **Zandahar Just Tiger Lily** – the 'Just' because she was the only one and the 'Tiger' because she was striped. I wish Lily luck

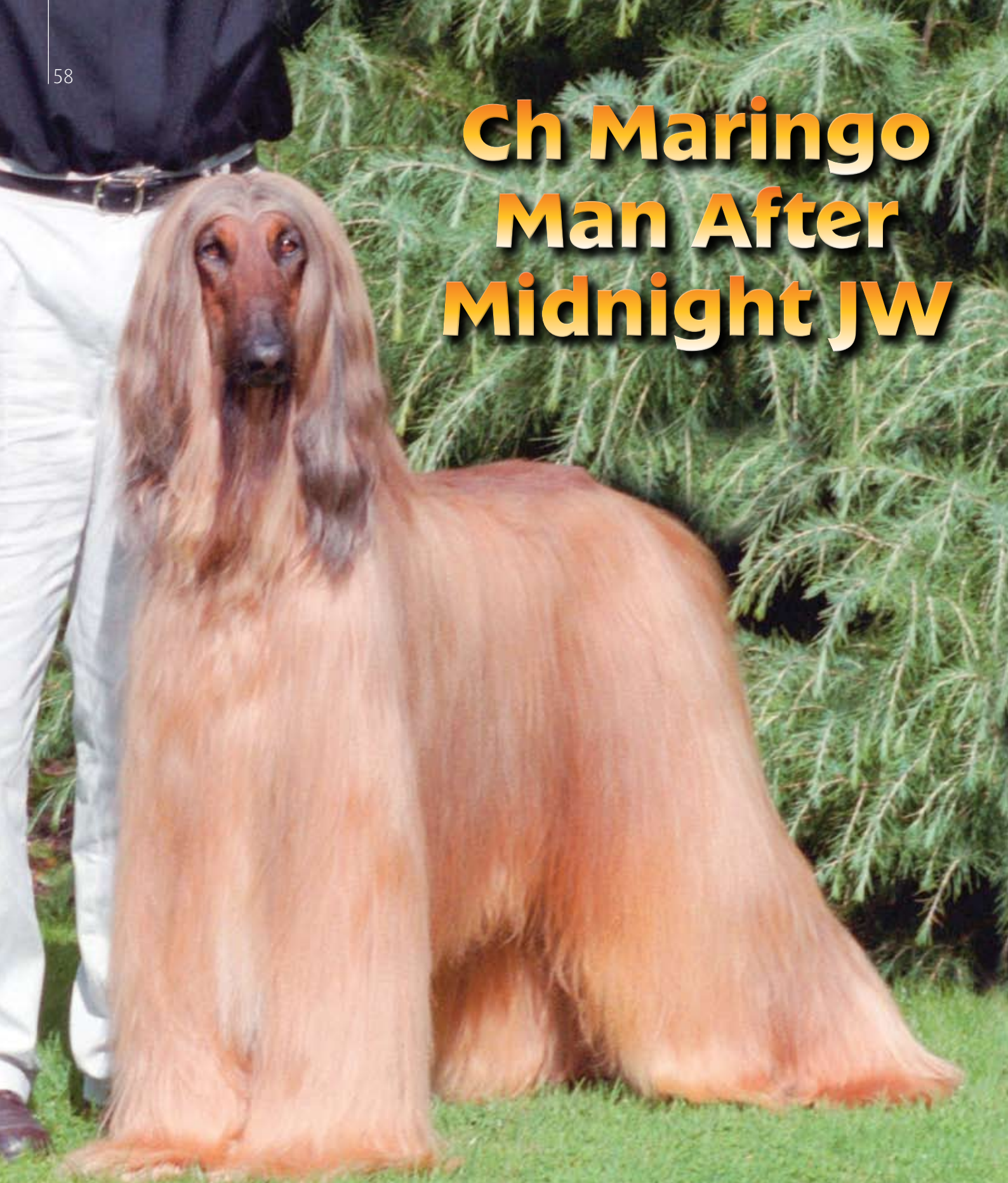

The story of Mou... Qanda Lhi's Moutik with Shechem

This is Moutik's story but it is probably good to start, like all good stories, at the beginning.

As most affie people know, the Tibetan Terrier show scene is fairly heavily populated with those of us who used to show and own Afghans. It has been said that the TT show scene is a bit like Eastbourne or Bournemouth; (with apologies to both those gorgeous places) for those of us in retirement from hurtling around the ring with the beautiful, but fast, Afghan hound. Although always my first love and I still keep in close touch, no longer could I manage. So it is that I now show TTs having owned them for a long time. I should say that they are a wonderful breed to own, full of character and personality and I wish I had owned them long ago.

The second ingredient in this story is Facebook. Loved by many but loathed and feared by many, with some justification, my story begins with Facebook, for without it none of this would have happened, and there would be no story of Mou.

I had for some time admired the Qanda Lhi's Tibetan Terriers and formed a pen pal type friendship with their owner/breeder, Lisa Del Monte. The photos of her TTs and her obviously warm friendship with all who owned one of her dogs was fascinating to me. She has her own closed Qanda Lhi group on Facebook, where they all chatted about their dogs and many other things, truly international from all parts of Europe and beyond, mutually supportive and, well, friendly. Birthdays are remembered, good wishes are sent, pictures admired, sympathy and advice given. Through all of this the threads, which bind it all, are Lisa and Qanda Lhi's.

Lisa told me that she and her friend Rosanna were coming to the UK and would be arriving at Heathrow, and would like to meet up, and we accepted. Terry and I set off taking two of our own Tibetan terriers with us. I recognised her immediately and we set off to get her hire car, and then to the hotel. We managed to get their hire car and get to the hotel with very limited English (Lisa and Rosanna) and NO Italian (me) but we managed with much laughter.

We only had a limited time to meet and talk, but by this time I was able to say we were interested in a little girl who would be called Qanda Lhi's Moutik (means little pearl).

We had absolutely no experience of bringing a puppy into the UK, and of course, Lisa wanted me to see her and I wanted to see her, so arrangements were made for me to go to Italy. I spoke with Pat Latimer and eventually we settled on Easyjet to Milan for me and flight back to Brussels with Alitalia where Terry would meet me at Brussels airport to take us home through the Tunnel.

Lisa was there to meet me at Milan with daughter the gorgeous Alice, and we began the long drive to Emilio Romagna region close to Parma, where Lisa, her other half Fabrizio, and the Qanda Lhi's live almost among the mountains in a picturesque village.

It was love at first sight, and arrangements were made by Lisa for Mou (as we called her) to fly back with me to Brussels where Terry would be waiting to take us home through the Channel Tunnel.

time flew

The next few days were spent with the Qanda Lhi's TTs, marvelous pasta, and enjoying a trip to Parma. The time flew past until it was time for Lisa's vet, Giovanni (what can I say, I promise you that is his name) to give Mou her final health check and worming treatment. In fact, this turned out to be someone who, when she walked in, had obviously lost her way and came from Prada or Gucci! How do they look like this with just a scarf and simple clothes? With many good wishes and a charming refusal to accept any money, (no money?!) we were done.

There was just one more thing, and that was to meet up for lunch with a couple we had become friendly with through Facebook. They were Paul and Michelle Sullivan from Brisbane, Australia, who had been in Italy – Lucca to be precise – for around 18 months with their Tibetan Terrier who travels everywhere with them. He is called Atticus, and has, in his breeding, Cheryl Johnson's Khados from the UK. Small world! They had made the journey especially in their hire

car and it was great to finally meet them and Atticus. I know that Paul and Michelle's story, together with Atticus, definitely needs a book of its own, and that is not my story. They had settled in Lucca as their base, where there was a whole population of dogs, including the Afghans who belonged to an agility club called "the flying dogs of Lucca". It does sound as though Lucca brings a whole new meaning to the phrase "dog friendly". Atticus had his Christmas lunch in a super trattoria along with all his human friends. There was nowhere Atticus could not go, bars, restaurants, shops, trains, etc. After a superb pasta lunch and some vino, they set off back to Lucca.

And so, it was time at 4am to leave my little villa next door to Lisa and Fabri, and take Mou on her journey in her little dog bag, with her passport. Lisa was unable to see us go (weepy), so Fabri drove me at Monza speeds to Milan, and finally, after some tears, it was time for Mou and me to get on the plane with her own little ticket, or biglietto.

Another stunning Italian showed us to our seat in the cabin, no hold for dogs flying Alitalia, oh no! A short time into our flight Mou decided the bag was not for her and, to the obvious disapproval of a very high flying looking lady with her laptop in the next seat, escaped, looked around, made herself comfortable on my knee, and looked out of the window. The Alitalia lady had no hesitation, "Bella piccolino" she said with a glare at high flying lady. Mou was given a biscuit and water, and high flying lady was dispatched to another seat so that Mou could have her own.

At last we landed with us last off the plane, and struggled to find our way through this vast airport with one puppy who had decided to WALK and not go into the BAG.

With only a nylon show lead, this was tricky. I eventually persuaded her back into the bag, I almost dropped her down a steep escalator before we eventually found our meeting place, but no Terry. It seemed the satnav had decided to stop working and Terry was lost in the cobbled streets of Brussels. By chance close to a shop smelling of baking bread, eventually a mum who was picking up her son from school offered to drive with Terry following to get him almost to the airport. I imagine that Terry was almost weeping with gratitude by then, and I certainly was almost weeping at the airport longing for the loo, but with nowhere to leave an extremely confident puppy who was by now strutting around attracting a great deal of attention!

Eventually, Terry arrived and the last leg of the journey passed smoothly with the doggy passport control efficient and, well, doggy friendly and the tunnel an absolute marvel, quiet quick and efficient. And CHEAP.

panache

Almost a year now, and Mou qualified for Crufts, where she had a very respectable 5th out of a high quality class of 12 handled with great expertise and panache by an extremely proud Fabrizio, who came over especially. As anyone who looks at the breed knows, the Tibetan Terrier entries are BIG, an entry of over 200 at Crufts, with shows regularly having entries of over 150...

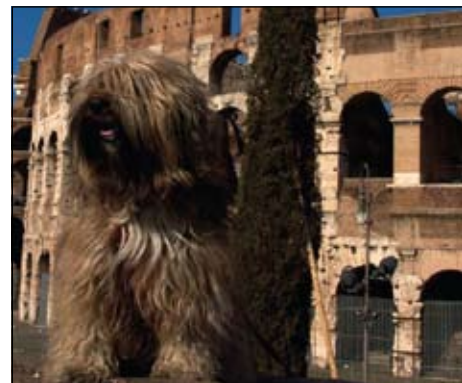

Shirley and Terry had been married for nearly 46 years, and were devoted to each other. As with all couples we are all presented with challenges, but they built on those, the chain becoming stronger as their time together became longer. They understood and respected each other. They both invested a great deal in their time together, when you mention one you automatically mention the other. I had always imagined them going on till they were in their hundreds, as I could not imagine either of them not being here.

Shirley as with most things, dealt with her diagnosis of bowel cancer in a very matter of fact way. She wanted to deal with things without drama or tears, which was probably her defence mechanism kicking in. She was determined not to be maudlin, though her biggest regret was that she would not see

her grandson, Billy, grow into a man. She was brave enough to phone the vicar at Christ Church, Derry Hill to ensure that there was space for her when the inevitable would happen.

She even got around to choosing hymns, though she had only managed to decide on Abide With Me. I would not have been surprised to have discovered that she had written her own eulogy. Time will tell! I only hope that I can do justice to her memory. Words somehow seem inadequate to measure the loss we all feel, and that big gap she will leave in so many of our lives.

perfect match

No one has acted as well as Shirley, rehoming Afghan Hounds. Always acting in the best interest of the dog, never persecuting previous owners, or their breeders. The well-being of the dog always came first. This probably sums Shirley up best in that she always put others first, and was always there to help. Through Shirley, Afghan rescue became more coordinated and cohesive. Shirley spent many hours endeavouring to find the perfect match for the displaced afghan, wherever the dog came from, without prejudice. The reputation of many breeders remain intact because of Shirley's discrete actions. She not only helped Afghans here in the UK, but has successfully rehomed Afghans from abroad, most recently one from Spain. The dog world owes a great deal to Shirley's actions. The day before she died, on her hospital bed, she spent time organising the rehoming of the Afghan from Spain.

Shirley had over the years been involved in many fund-raising events. Many will remember the Afghan Rallies at Terry and Shirley's house at Studley, which were filled with fun, both for the humans and affies. Those involved with LAAD, (Love An Afghan Day), the auctions and the unforgettable Men's Calendar, which had to be reprinted, and was even hung in the Kennel Club, though that one did get stolen. All made possible through Shirley's involvement and organisation.

Shirley set up the website with Brian, so that there would be a central point of reference for Afghan Rescue, and had become the Afghan Hound Breed Council rep for Afghan Rescue. The lady will be sorely missed.

Shirley loved all animals apart from mice, rats, May bugs and wasps, though Afghans were her favourite. She had special heart hounds who were most probably the males

that she owned with Terry and Hannah. To her dying day she couldn't watch videos of her Afghans that had gone onto Rainbow Bridge. She will be delighted to be reunited with them, though she was certainly not ready as she wanted to do so much more in her life.

in our dotage

We would often joke that we would be still going to dog shows in our dotage, probably on mobility scooters, preferably chauffeured by a young man in uniform, leather boots and a cap.

Dog shows will never be the same for Roxy or me. Roxy gets very agitated if I have not picked up Shirley to go to the dog show. She prods me if I do not take the road to Derry Hill and stares at me. She always greeted Shirley with a love bite as she got into the car, always finding the most tender spots. She may not be there in body but she will be there in spirit.

For as long as I can remember, Terry, Shirley, Brian and I have spent Christmas Day together, all pulling together to prepare a ginormous feast; such fun, relaxing times, with no barriers as to what was said, just so comfortable together sharing the day, with light hearted banter, total bliss!

Often Hannah, Richard and Billy would be there, to share the day. Christmas just won't be the same.

chatting

There are many humorous stories that we all could share. On our way to dog shows or meetings, Shirley and I were notorious for chatting away, and going the wrong way, ending up at the Severn Bridge when we should have been on the M5, coming back from the North East, exiting the M1, for the M18, only to get back onto the M1, and taking a longer, but more scenic journey home. We somehow ended up on the Toll road on the M6, not once but twice, and had to pay twice to get off of it. When we went to see Allan Brooks, who she lovingly called Uncle, to bring back Mable, we missed a turning, but we always followed our nose and got to our destination safely. This was always because we were chatting, and Shirley was directing, of course.

Shirley was the sister I never had, and I shall miss her, we often spoke three or four times a week on the phone, and I shall miss that. She has been in my life for nearly forty years, and has been a big part of that. She has been a part of all of our lives, and some of you will have known her for longer than I have. I shall, and I know we will all, miss her being here.

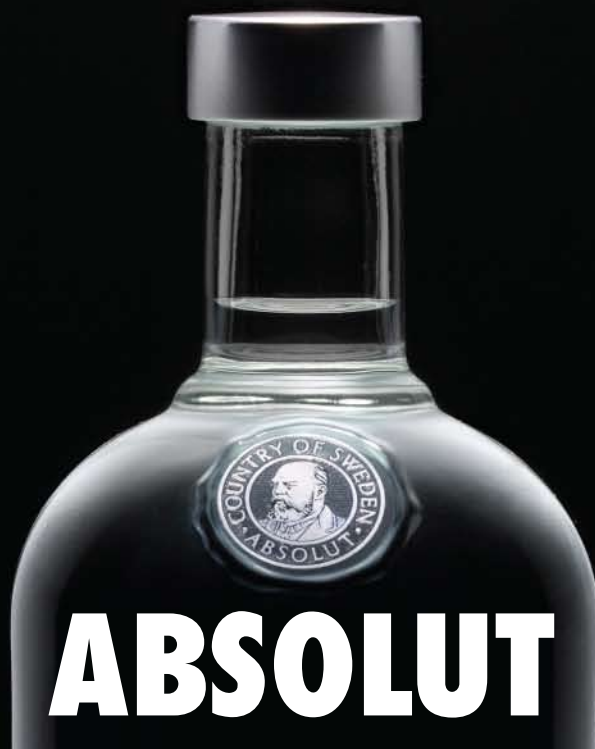
